Court of Appeal for BC

To Whom It May Or Should Concern:

I am used to this sort of evasive replies from the court's legal counsel and other officials so I waste no time on addressing it.

As I noted in my letter of March 13, 2023, there are recipients of the letter aside from the Chief Justice of BC.

I confirm that by early morning today, the letter was sent to all 338 members of Parliament among others.

Just in a matter of a few hours after forwarding that letter, it is evident from the MPs' replies that **there is bipartisan agreement about the urgency of confronting the existing direct or indirect foreign interference in Canadian institutions by the terrorist regime of the Islamic Republic.**

I iterate that any further misconduct of an institution that has covered up for or, otherwise, supported the regime of the Islamic Republic and/or its enablers is closely watched and scrutinized.

Continuing to block the access of a victim of that regime's enablers to the justice system is of that nature.

FYI, below I am including some excerpts from the MPs' replies that are representative of the MPs' overall responses received so far.

"We appreciate you making us aware of this situation, and we welcome the sharing of your letter to the Chief Justice of British Columbia."

"Illicit interference by any foreign agent or power is gravely serious, and must be addressed with the immediacy that this issue deserves. The concerns you have outlined are particularly salient due to their association with the repressive Islamic Republic of Iran."

"[We] continue to remain vigilant on the issue of foreign interference. Canada must get serious about protecting its national interests, its vulnerable diaspora (including those from Iran and China), and its institutions."

"[The MP] has become well aware of direct and indirect activities by the IRGC in Canada over the past few weeks as he has been meeting with many members of the Iranian community and has participated in several roundtables/panels regarding Iran. I have forwarded your email to [the MP's] personal inbox, and to our team that has been dealing with Iranian matters."

"Hi, thanks for reaching out! I really appreciate you taking the time to share your strong convictions with me regarding Canada's relations with the Islamic Republic of Iran. I hear your concerns, and I greatly value your input. ... The time for empty words and hollow announcements is over. ... Please be assured that I will continue to closely follow developments surrounding these issues."

"As [your email] pertains to Chrystia's role as Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance, we are forwarding your message to the Deputy Prime Minister's Office, which is best equipped to address your email."

"We have forwarded [your email] to the office of the Honourable David Lametti, Minister of Justice and Attorney General of Canada, and of the Honourable Marco E. L. Mendicino, Minister of Public Safety, as this issue falls under their purview."
